

Integrated Mersey Palliative Care Team (IMPaCT)

Information for health professionals

IMPaCT is the **Consultant-led, integrated, multi-professional palliative care service** to support Liverpool and South Sefton patients with a life limiting, progressive condition.

IMPaCT is a multi-professional service offering a single point of access and referral to palliative care.

The service operates from two IMPaCT hubs based at:

- Marie Curie Hospice: Patients registered with a central or South Liverpool GP.
- Woodlands Hospice: Patients registered with a North Liverpool or South Sefton GP.

The IMPaCT hub will not take over the care of the patient but will;

- Support the regular care team in identifying their specialist palliative care needs.
- Identify the services which can meet the patient's needs.

Patients remain under the IMPaCT caseload from the point of referral to the end of their life. They will be monitored and reviewed depending on their needs. Patients, carers and their healthcare team can contact the service at any time, without the need for a repeat referral.

IMPaCT is a partnership between Marie Curie, Mersey Care NHS Foundation Trust, Liverpool University Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust and Woodlands Hospice.

Referral Criteria

- Patients aged 18 or over
 with a diagnosis of a life
 limiting progressive disease
- Registered with a Liverpool or South Sefton GP
- The patient requires palliative care assessment
- Patient informed and agrees to referral

Exclusion Criteria

- Patient does not have a life limiting progressive condition
- Patient does not consent to referral to the service

Discharge Criteria

- Patient no longer has a life limiting progressive condition
- Patient no longer resident in the catchment area
- Patient declines further input from the service
